Pacific Waters Spa features a sauna, steam,

waterfall showers, private whirlpools, outdoor relaxation areas, a salon, and stateof-the-art fitness center.

Family fun includes Slyders Water Playground with three water slides, two splash and one wading pool, main pool, and two fire pits. 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Hotel Del Coronado

FOR MORE THAN 125 years, Hotel del Coronado has epitomized luxury beach resort living. Designated a National Historic Landmark in 1977, it has attracted Hollywood's elite: U.S. presidents Franklin D. Roosevelt, Gerald Ford and Jimmy Carter; and a long list of other notables. Its signature exterior was also the setting for Marilyn Monroe, Tony Curtis and Jack Lemmon's 1958 film classic, *"Some Like it Hot."*

Today, accommodations range from historic Victorian to modern in Ocean Towers, poolside California Cabana buildings, and right on the sand, one to 3-bedroom Beach Village villas and free-standing cottages with fireplaces, marble baths, and patios or balconies.

Among a long list of activities are sunset clambakes with live music and beach games; toasting marshmallows around your private beach bonfire; relaxing poolside in a luxury cabana with a sofa lounge, large TV, refrigerator; yoga on the sand, and fitness classes on the lawn. There's biking, boogie boarding, beach spin, sailing, surfing, spin, stand-up paddleboarding, and across the street is Glorietta Marina where you can take sailing lessons, rent a speedboat, jet ski, water ski, kayak, paddleboat, fish or sail aboard a captained private yacht.
