Activities Descriptions

“E Hula Mai”: Enjoy your hands telling a story with music during a Hula Lesson. The history of the Hula resonates all throughout Hawaii to this day, and is a beautiful way for a story to be told. Meets in the Cultural Ambassador’s Lounge. *Children 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult. Complimentary.*

Koi Fish Feeding: Visit our main Lobby Entrance to share in the experience of feeding our Koi Fish.

Lei of Aloha “Haku”: Learn about the history, meaning of the lei and the method of haku lei making. Meets in the Cultural Ambassador’s Lounge. *Children 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult. Complimentary.*

Village Walking Trails: Kapalua hillside is home to a cart path that once was the Village Golf Course, Today the area is lush with guava and monarch butterflies. This guided hike will take you to a beautiful lake with ducks and koi! Hikers will meet guide on the porte-cochère. Meets \$20 Adults/\$10 Children Under 12•Bottled Water Included.

Maunalei Arboretum Cloud Forest Hike: The Maunalei Arboretum was created in the 1920s by D.T. Fleming. Mr. Flemmings was a plantation manager of Honolua Ranch and he traveled the world seeking new plant and tree species that would complement our island home This is a guided hike through the beautiful canopy of Banyan Trees and giant New Zealand Kauri Trees. There is a beautiful lookout onto the Pu’u Kuki Watershed. Hikers will meet guide on the porte-cochère. *24 Hour Reservations are Required. This hike is limited to the first 6 guests. Adults: \$20/Children Under 12: \$10•Bottled Water Included.*

Paintbox’s Children’s Friday Night Out: Children will explore Kapalua Bay by twilight for ghost crabs, geckos, toads and nocturnal shearwater sea birds. Dinner is included. \$70 per child, ages 5-12 6pm-10:00pm.

Paintbox’s Children’s Saturday Night Out: Children will have the opportunity learn about the night sky, create their own constellation kaleidoscope, stargazing and storytelling, create glow in the dark necklaces AND enjoy making ice cream sundaes!
