

At Montage Kapalua Bay on the island of Maui, the spirit of Hawaii merges with a true sense of balance and harmony. Set beachfront atop picturesque Kapalua Bay, the 24-acre resort is the ideal destination to experience "aloha."

To create the resort lifestyle, Montage Kapalua Bay engaged Pacific AquaTech, Inc. to design the numerous pools, spas, and water features at the the resort. Included in the design is a 1,600-square-foot adult pool, an 8,000-square-foot multi-tiered resort pool, multiple spas, the spa's water features (which includes a lap pool, men's spa, women's spa, and family spa), and the beach club's pool.



Pacific AquaTech, Inc. worked closely with the architect, WCIT Architects and the landscape architect McCelvey Associates to develop the resort's water amenities. The intent behind the design was to create a resort pool area that utilized water and tropical landscaping, creating an oasis that reflected the traditional Hawaiian concept of Ahupua'a-the division of property that followed the watershed from the mountains to the ocean. With the sloped topography of the site and the panoramic ocean view, the Ahupua'a concept was tastefully integrated into the project.

"Utilizing the beautiful tropical surroundings to complement the existing design, enhanced pool lighting and new poolside furniture and amenities were added, providing Montage guests and residents with a truly unique and world class experience," comments Bill Claypool, executive vice president of development at Montage Hotels & Resorts.
