An interactive activity for all to enjoy! Maui Nui Seabird Recovery Project (MNSRP) invites guests to learn about the native wedge-tailed shearwater birds. To begin our talk story session, guests will meet at Cliff House where MNSRP representatives will provide a casual educational talk about the importance of this species and its relationship to Kapalua Bay. Guests are kindly asked to wear closed-toe shoes as the session will continue outdoors at Hawea Point, near the resort. Here, we will observe the birds returning to their burrows and witness the seasonal adult recaptures, band reading and banding of new birds by MNSRP team.
